The Art of Travel at Searcy's, St Pancras



Afternoon tea is served in a suitcase at St Pancras station, paying homage to 12 European destinations and celebrating the art of travel. It takes place at a [summer travel pop-up at Searcy's Champagne Bar](#) in the station, aimed at those hopping on the Eurostar to the continent, but open to everyone. The menu includes French Opera gâteau, Belgian white chocolate mousse, and passion fruit Swiss meringue pie, and when the pop-up opens in mid-July, each of the 12 booths will be themed on a different country.
