About the venue

{10-11} Carlton House Terrace is a Grade I-listed Georgian townhouse set within one of London's most prestigious and fashionable addresses. Built in the 1820s as a grand backdrop to The Mall and St James's Park, the building was designed by renowned architect John Nash and features striking period details, elegant cornice work and exceptional views across some of London's most iconic landmarks. Rich in history and architectural significance, it offers an outstanding setting for memorable events.



The **British Academy** moved to this distinguished building to extend its work encouraging academic excellence by funding research and furthering discourse and innovation in the humanities and social sciences.

The venue spans two original townhouses, each with its own distinctive entrance, creating an immediate sense of arrival and a genuine ‘wow factor’ for guests. With seven flexible event spaces filled with natural daylight, the venue can accommodate a wide range of occasions. In October 2024, three additional double-height, double-glazed spaces were unveiled, expanding the offering to ten rooms and combining contemporary facilities with the character of a historic setting.

{10–11} Carlton House Terrace is available for exclusive hire, hosting seated dinners for up to 100 guests, standing receptions for up to 200, and conferences for up to 125.

Founded in 2005, Champagne Barons de Rothschild is a family-owned wine estate dear to the hearts of the three branches of the Rothschild Family – today represented by Philippe Sereys de Rothschild (Château Mouton Rothschild), Ariane de Rothschild (Château Clarke – Groupe Edmond de Rothschild), and Eric and his daughter Saskia de Rothschild (Château Lafite Rothschild).

For the first time in their history, the Barons have joined forces to create a joint estate and together produce their unique interpretation of a Grand Vin de Champagne, combining the elegance of Chardonnay, extended ageing and the purity of a minimalist dosage.

Champagne Bruno Paillard was founded in 1981 with a singular ambition: to craft Champagne defined by purity and precision. Fully independent and family-owned, it is now led by Alice Paillard, who continues the vision she shares with her father through refined cuvées.

The maison farms 30 hectares of vineyards, covering around 70% of its needs—an unusually high proportion in Champagne. The remaining fruit comes from long-standing grower partners. Certified High Environmental Value Level 3 and guided by adapted biodynamic principles, vineyards prohibit pesticides and herbicides.

Only first-pressed juice is used. Multi-vintage blends include 25–50% reserve wines from a perpetual reserve spanning over 40 years. Dosage remains Extra-Brut (under 6g/L), with lees ageing up to 12 years for depth and precision. Limited production and selective distribution ensure Bruno Paillard Champagnes are found in the finest restaurants and wine merchants worldwide.

Champagne Canard-Duchêne's story is one of heritage and vision, shaped by the passion of its founders, Victor Canard and Léonie Duchêne. In 1868, they established the Maison, determined to express the exceptional potential of their hillside terroir in the Montagne de Reims. Over 150 years later, this pioneering spirit continues to guide the House. With a bold rebranding, Canard-Duchêne unveils the Iconic Collection, marking a new era while honouring its legacy. The Maison has also reduced the bottle weight by 13%, reinforcing its commitment to sustainability.

CHAMPAGNE CASTELNAU

The House of Castelnaud is located in the heart of Reims, and flagship Castelnaud Brut NV showcases the prolonged ageing that defines the signature Castelnaud style. This deliberate choice was introduced many years ago, in the pursuit of a complex champagne that would stand apart from the rest. Aged for a minimum of 5 years in the cellars, it celebrates the rich diversity of terroirs, from which Chardonnay, the majority grape in the blend, is sourced, to impart its full freshness, depth and length.

Cellar Master Carine Bailleul crafts Castelnaud's exceptional wines and her talents have been widely acknowledged, along with multiple top awards for the entire Castelnaud range.

For one of Champagne's most forward-thinking producers, Drappier has no shortage of historic roots. An eighth-generation family business, the house was founded in 1808 and occupies magnificent twelfth-century cellars built by Cistercian monks. Having spearheaded the revival of Pinot Noir in the region in the 1930s, Drappier continues to innovate by being the only house to ferment every format and was the first to become carbon neutral.

Over half of Drappier's production comes from the family's own vineyards near their base in Urville. Viticulture is close to organic, with horse-drawn ploughing and cover crops and natural fertiliser used.

Founded in 1859 and still proudly family-owned and independent, Duval-Leroy stands as one of the rare Champagne Houses to have preserved its heritage across six generations. Based in Vertus, in the heart of the Côte des Blancs, the House has built its identity on a deep connection to the vineyard, meticulous craftsmanship, and an unwavering pursuit of excellence. Duval-Leroy draws strength from its vineyard roots, with over 75% of grapes coming from its own estates, ensuring quality, authenticity, and a strong sense of terroir.

A true reference in the world of gastronomy, Duval-Leroy is present in over 300 Michelin-starred restaurants and maintains long-standing partnerships with Relais & Châteaux and the Ducasse Group. Chefs across the globe value the House's refined style, crafted to elevate the most delicate food pairings and enhance haute cuisine. Duval-Leroy continues to shape the story of a Champagne house rooted in tradition yet resolutely forward-looking.

EPC (short for EPiCurean) Champagne was established in 2019 by three friends, Jérôme Queige, Camille Gilardi and Édouard Roy. With a penchant for the epicurean lifestyle, this dynamic trio are committed to shaking up the traditional structure of the Champagne region. Working with select grower partners, each cuvée in the EPC range represents a specific terroir with the intention to take you on a journey through Champagne and highlight the diversity of the region. Cellar master Richard Dailly works closely with EPC's grower partners (all of whom either practise sustainable viticulture or are transitioning to organic or biodynamic viticulture) to co-create the wines from start to finish.


In collaboration with the Chassenay d'Arce cooperative, the fruit was grown in the Vallée de l'Arce on clay, limestone and marl soils. The grapes were harvested by hand.

Champagne Joseph Perrier is based in Châlons-en-Champagne, where the delightful team at our top-rated visitor centre is waiting to welcome you and show you around on your next visit to Champagne. Founded in 1825, the Maison celebrated its 200th anniversary last year; today Benjamin Fourmon is the 6th generation to run this family-owned jewel.

One of the original Grande Marque Houses, with the cellars based in the city of Châlons-en-Champagne, their vineyards are all south-facing, spread around the House in Cumières and nearby in the Montagne de Reims, Vallée de la Marne and near Vitry.

Cheffe de Cave Nathalie Laplaige has been in charge of the cellars since 2017. The 2018 vintage presented at the Bubbly Show is the first made completely under her control, and has already been awarded 95 points by the Decanter and 96 points by Wine Enthusiast.

Laurent-Perrier is a family-owned House that has always had a pioneering and innovative role in Champagne, with a distinctive style marked by aromatic complexity and exceptional fullness and length. This style is achieved by focusing on the three main winemaking know-hows of the House.

First, the assemblage of reserve wines; Laurent-Perrier is the only house whose most prestigious cuvée, Grand Siècle, is not vintage but numbered. Second, the maceration technique, which offers to our rosé champagnes unequalled aromas, revealing all the richness of the best crus of Pinot Noir. Finally, zero dosage; Laurent-Perrier has been a pioneer in the sans dosage category since 1981, revealing the true minerality of the Champagne region's terroir.

As the world's No. 1 Champagne, Moët & Chandon stands as a testament to unparalleled craftsmanship and a commitment to elegance that spans nearly three centuries.

Founded in 1811 in Épernay, Maison Perrier-Jouët is one of France's most historic champagne houses, but also one of its most distinctive, renowned for its floral and intricate Champagnes which reveal the true essence of the Chardonnay grape and an enduring tradition of savoir-faire – an unparalleled expertise of only seven cellar masters since its foundation. A boutique House with a family spirit, Perrier-Jouët has been profoundly influenced by its founders' love of nature and art – twin inspirations which allow it to create exceptional experiences and moments of wonder that enhance everyday life.

Since its 1902 collaboration with Art Nouveau pioneer Emile Gallé, creator of the anemone design for its Perrier-Jouët Belle Epoque prestige cuvée, Perrier-Jouët has commissioned work from established and emerging artists including Bethan Laura Wood, Daniel Arsham, Noé Duchaufour-Lawrance, Miguel Chevalier, Makoto Azuma, Tord Boontje, Studio Glithero, Simon Heijdens, Vik Muniz, mischer'traxler, Ritsue Mishima, Andrew Kudless and Fernando Laposse.

Founded over 240 years ago by Florens-Louis Heidsieck, Piper-Heidsieck's historical success has been shaped by a forward-thinking, pioneering spirit which continues today. The quality of Piper-Heidsieck wines has never been finer, leading them to be the most-awarded Champagne House of the last century and earn the title of 'Supreme World Champion' at the 2025 Champagne & Sparkling Wine World Championships. Their chief winemaker, Emilien Boutillat, is one of the youngest in Champagne's history and has been driving standards even higher at Piper-Heidsieck since 2018. Emilien's exceptional talents led him to be named 'Sparkling Winemaker of the Year' by the IWC in both 2023 and 2021.

In 2022, Piper-Heidsieck was one of the first Champagne Houses to achieve B Corp Certification, illustrating an ongoing commitment to sustainability and improving both their social and environmental impact on the planet.

CHAMPAGNE POL ROGER

Champagne Pol Roger focused early on a dry style of Champagne that was favoured by the English palate and Great Britain became its leading market by the late 1850s, with the House's first Royal Warrant being awarded by Queen Victoria in 1877. In 2024, Pol Roger was granted a Royal Warrant by His Majesty King Charles III.

Pol Roger currently owns 92 hectares in the Vallée de la Marne, Montagne de Reims and the Côte de Blancs. The cellars stretch for 9.5km with the deepest sitting at 34m below street level, allowing for prolonged second fermentation at a low temperature of 9°C or less.

Champagne Pol Roger now sits in the hands of the fifth and sixth generations of the Pol Roger family and remains proudly family-owned and fiercely independent.

Louis Pommery, wealthy from wool and textiles, joined Narcisse Greno, who founded the House in 1836. It was under Madame Pommery's leadership in 1858 that Pommery gained global acclaim. In 1868, she opened the neo-Gothic Elizabethan Domaine in Reims to the world; recognised by its pale-blue façade and 18km of chalk cellars providing ideal ageing conditions. In 1874, Madame Pommery introduced the 'first brut' champagne, made from carefully selected grapes, resulting in exceptional wine without the need to be excessively sweetened with sugar.

Taittinger remains one of the few Champagne Houses to be owned and actively managed by the family named on the label. The origins date back to 1734, when the original House was founded by Jacques Fourneaux. The Taittinger link was established in 1931 when Pierre Taittinger, the founder of today's company, acquired the House. Pierre spent time in the Champagne region when serving in the 1st World War as a young cavalry officer. Stationed at the Château de la Marquetterie, he fell in love with this remarkable property and its vineyards and eventually purchased the company. Today, the Reims-based House is headed up by Pierre's great-grandchildren Vitalie and Clovis.

Taittinger's home is situated above miles of chalk tunnels and cellars. These 4th-century UNESCO-listed cellars once belonged to the Benedictine monks of the Abbey of St Nicaise and are perfect for the slow ageing process required for great Champagne.

Veuve Clicquot, a Champagne Maison steeped in audacity and innovation, traces its origins to 1772 in Reims, France. However, its true legacy was forged by the indomitable Barbe-Nicole Ponsardin, better known as Madame Clicquot. Widowed at 27, she defied societal norms of her time to take control of the family business in 1805. Her vision and entrepreneurial spirit earned her the moniker “La Grande Dame de Champagne”.

Today, the House remains a symbol of bold luxury, celebrating “Solaire Culture” – a bright, optimistic outlook – embodied by its iconic yellow label.







Founded by Bob and Annie Lindo in 1989, Camel Valley started with 8,000 vines in the heart of the Cornish countryside and quickly earned recognition, winning a medal at their first English Wine competition. Over the years, the winery has received numerous national and international awards for both still and sparkling wines. The vineyard has also received tourism and industry accolades, maintaining high standards and a commitment to quality. Bob's proudest moment came in 2005 with an International Wine Challenge Gold Medal for Camel Valley 'Cornwall' sparkling wine, the first IWC Gold for an English sparkling.

Now, second-generation winemaker Sam Lindo has secured multiple UK wine awards. Most notably, he won the best sparkling rosé in the world on four separate occasions and was the runner-up for IWC's best sparkling winemaker in the world.

Camel Valley are Royal Warrant Holders for both the King and Queen.

Lord John Sainsbury first recognised the potential of this Hampshire plot, reimagining it as a vineyard capable of producing world-class traditional-method sparkling wine.

Nestled within Preston Farm in the Candover Valley, Candover Brook reflects the conservation-led vision of Mark and Julian Sainsbury, who champion regenerative farming to enhance soil health, biodiversity and reduce reliance on chemicals.

At just five hectares, this single-vineyard estate prioritises quality over scale. Brut and Rosé wines are crafted in small quantities with patience and precision, while extended lees ageing reveals the depth and character of this exceptional English terroir.

Named after the rare chalk stream flowing through the valley – home to the protected English white-clawed crayfish – the brook and its wildlife are honoured in the wine's distinctive label.



Crush&Brisk was born out of friendship and a passion for wine and winemaking.

Crush&Brisk is a micro-negociant based in Battersea, London. After years of visiting and helping out in vineyards and then doing some intensive studying at Plumpton College, Frances and John decided to take their interests in wine to the next level, creating something of their own, but wanted to do it close to home in London.

The 2019 vintage is Crush&Brisk's first release. Employing minimal intervention combined with vintage-dependent experimentation, Crush&Brisk is about being creative and having fun while championing both where the grapes come from, as well as where the wine is made. The grapes for 2019 came from the beautiful Shotley Peninsula in Suffolk. The wine was bottled in June 2020 and disgorged in November 2023 with a 5g dosage. Production was limited to 1200 bottles.

Domaine Evremond Classic Cuvée NV is an exceptional English quality sparkling wine, born from the friendship between Pierre-Emmanuel Taittinger of Champagne Taittinger and Patrick McGrath MW. Located in Chilham, Kent, the estate is named after Charles de Saint-Évremond, a renowned Frenchman who introduced the early wines of Champagne to the court of Charles II.

Edition I of the Classic Cuvée comprises wine from Domaine Evremond's original plots across two vintages. A blend of 55% Pinot Noir, 35% Chardonnay and 10% Pinot Meunier, it was bottled in 2021 and spent over 3 years on the lees before being released in April 2025. The intention was to create a wine that expresses the heart and soul of the Kentish terroir, with its chalky soils and oceanic influence. The resulting cuvée is pure, elegant, and distinctive, with a revealing fresh and flinty character.

Greyfriars Vineyard is a family-owned vineyard and winery located on the sunny south-facing chalk slopes of the Hog's Back at Puttenham, just outside Guildford in the beautiful Surrey Hills. The 40-acre vineyard was first established in 1989 and boasts a state-of-the-art tasting room, winery and a chalk cave for ageing their sparkling wines.

Greyfriars crafts award-winning traditional-method sparkling and still wines exclusively from estate-grown grapes. Its wines have earned international acclaim, including gold medals at the Decanter World Wine Awards and Sommelier Wine Awards, while Cuvée Royale 2015 won the Vintage Classic Cuvée Trophy at the Wine GB Awards.

The vineyard is open to visitors all year round and offers experiences including exciting tours and tasting events, an outdoor wine bar in the summer and a wine club that provides members with discounted wine and access to exclusive members' events.
